- that M/s.Sri Venkata Sai Educational Society, Mahabubnagar should abide by the Dentists Act, 1948 as amended from time (1)to time and the regulations framed there under for establishment of new Dental College;
- that before applying for permissic: to establish the new Dental College, M/s.Sri Venkata Sai Educational Society, Mahabubnagar, shall ensure that the conditions risid down in the scheme relating to Dental Colleges Welsons to in clause (a) and (b) of Sub-Section (All of Section 10-4 of the Dentists Act, 1948, as amended from time to time as annexed to Regulations-2 of the Regulations relating to establishment of new Dental Colleges made by the Dental Council of India. are fulfilled. - if ultimately, the Government of India/Dental Council of India grant permission for establishment of new Dental College by the said Society, the admission of students into the college and the fee structure should in accordance with the rules and regulations or any executive orders issued or to be issued by the State or Central Governments or Dental Council of India or University of Health Sciences from time to time.
- That the Essentiality Certificate will be valid for a period of (2) years and the management of the society should complete all required facilities to commence the college during validity of the Essentiality Certificate. If the management fails to complete required facilities and establish the college within the validity period of Essentiality Certificate, the Essentiality Certificate issued will be withdrawn without any notice.
